Breaking News

Email in from the chair of Giffnock Community Council (Jack Powell)

In response to your email regarding membership issues in Giffnock Community Council.

I referred your enquiries initially to ERC as they are responsible for the Rules of Establishment under which community councils operate, and that they would be best placed to deal with matters relating to the interpretation of these rules.

However, since they have passed the issue back to us:-

YYYYYYYYXX approached the community council shortly after it was established in September last year. As YYY is resident in the Merrylee Park/Braidbar Area, and as the membership compliment for that area was full, we were not able to co-opt YYY. I liaised with ERC regarding using the associate membership option and received no objections from them. (They are the ultimate arbiters regarding the rules of establishment). At the time also indicated that YYY was looking for alternative accommodation in another area of Giffnock, which would then allow GCC to co-opt YYY.

The legislation is perfectly clear, therefore it appears that this angel is not and cannot be an associate as they do not fit the criteria.
